

2022 FRANKLIN COUNTY FAIR TRACTOR PULL RULES

1. No alcohol or drugs
2. Puller must remain seated on tractor while pulling in competition.
3. Decisions of the flagman and sled operator are final
4. Tractor front end may come up 12" max (for the one event, may pull without wheeler bars) as determined by flagman. Pull will be measured at that point.
5. The sled or tractor out-of-bounds line is the chalk lines or stakes. Tractor/Sled going out of bounds will be a disqualification.
6. Any weights or parts dropped or dragged on the ground will disqualify the puller.
7. Excessive fluid, oil, fuel, or water dropped by the tractor will disqualify the puller at the flagman's discretion.
8. If any competitor's crew is on the track during the pull, the puller will be disqualified.
9. All drawbars must be locked and **SOLID** when pulling.
10. Sled spotting is allowed if done while in staging area.
11. Drivers' meeting at sled before the pull.
12. Tractors may pull only once in any class
13. Pullers must have signed waiver and paid before pulling.
14. Puller must be 18 years of age or older. 15–17-year-olds may pull with signed waiver and must be able to operate the tractor to be pulled, to the satisfaction of the officials in charge.
15. **Gas, Diesel or LP for LP tractors only. NO other injected fuels.**
16. No restarts for any reason in any class if the sled moves, (unless it is sled operator error.)
17. Torq down two times
18. **Tech personnel decision is final**

TRACTOR QUALIFICATION

1. Seat must have stock mounting.
2. Pulling point must be 18" from center of rear axle.
3. No object may protrude past 24 in. from front of the front casting and rear weights may not be more than 12 in. from the tire.
4. 3pt. weight mounting bars must be in a fixed/locked position while pulling.
5. Hitch must be horizontal loop type and have a 3" opening. (Sled hook must swivel in tractor hitch.) ****A CLEVIS MAY BE USED FOR A ONE EVENT LIMIT and the clevis must be solid** NO STRAIGHT CLEVIS, MUST BE A TWISTED CLEVIS.**
6. Sled operators **WILL NOT** furnish a clevis.
7. (8a.) Hitch must be factory appearing and (8b.) be in a fixed position, and deemed safe.
8. Sled operator will give only 1 warning if hitch is not accessible, (operators will not crawl under weights to reach hitch).
9. Pulling point cannot be over 20" high.
10. Wheelie Bars will be mandatory. **There will be a ONE EVENT LIMIT where the wheelie bar rule will not be enforced, BUT THERE WILL BE A 12 INCH HEIGHT LIMIT ON THE FRONT END OF THE TRACTOR.** Wheelie bars must not be more than 8 inches off the ground, have a pad a minimum of 5 x 5 inches square flat, 32" from center of axle, and be able to support the weight of the tractor on pad.
11. No wheels may be removed from tractor.
12. Tractor must be a 1970 or older model (first date of manufacture).
13. Removable side shields are allowed.
14. No moveable weights.
15. All shift on the go tractors is allowed 2 shifts only.
16. Factory shipping weights will be used.
